- ✓ I will only use ICT in school for school purposes.
- ✓ I will not tell other people my ICT passwords and only use my own logon details.
- ✓ I will only open or delete my own files.
- ✓ I will make sure that all ICT contact with other children and adults is responsible, polite and sensible.
- ✓ I will not deliberately look for, save or send anything that could be unpleasant or nasty. If I accidentally find anything like this I will tell my teacher immediately.
- ✓ I will not give out my own details such as my name, phone number or home address. I will not arrange to meet anyone on the internet.
- ✓ I will be responsible for my behaviour when using ICT because I know that these rules are to keep me safe.
- ✓ I will support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any images, video, sounds or text that could upset any member of the school community when I'm at school or home.
- ✓ I know that my use of ICT, including Google Classroom, can be checked and that my parent/carer will be contacted if a member of school staff is concerned about my e-Safety.
- ✓ I know that what I do on and offline at school is monitored to help keep me safe.
- ✓ I know that I am not allowed to bring my own devices to school unless I have been given permission to do so.
- ✓ I know that if I break the rules I might not be allowed to use a computer or iPad in school and my parents will be informed.
