The changes have enabled more family members to be accessing the messages and information about children. • The new website has enabled families to share their views on key elements of school through online surveys. • Parents able to book Parent Teacher Consultations via new website. • Changes made to parent meetings, e.g. different nights for the 'Meet the Teacher' evenings to avoid clashes
<p><i>'Please work in partnership with the school community to raise and secure the funds needed to support the rebuild of the school.'</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fund our future has led to a very impressive effort to raise additional funds for the new school • New group formed to oversee and plan the Fund our Future campaign, they produced a timetable of events sharing responsibility across the classes • The Fund our Future Campaign wanted a visual display in school to look at the progress of each class in their fundraising efforts • A wider range of fundraising activities e.g. quiz night, film night, Greatest Showman sing along, Year 6 Fiver Challenge all accessing different elements of our school community • The school has been represented at local events e.g. Heaton's Artisan Market, Steel Band at local events
