### The child/children will:

- ✓ I will come to school **well rested and ready to learn**

- ✓ Support the school's **healthy eating policy** with regards to packed lunches/mid-morning snacks, being mindful of the Nut free approach
- ✓ Support the activities of the **Parent Teacher Association**
- ✓ Ensure my child's **Uniform** and **PE kit** and other relevant items (e.g. bag) meet the school's policy, are properly labelled and in school **every day during term time**.
- ✓ Support and adhere to all school policies.

### The school will:

- ✓ Build and sustain a **close partnership** through **being open and welcoming at all times**, and through offering opportunities for you to become involved in the daily life of our school
- ✓ Keep you closely informed about **school activities** through regular letters home, our website, newsletters, texts, Twitter and notices about special events
- ✓ Help your child to **achieve the highest standards of work and behaviour** through building good relationships and developing a sense of responsibility
- ✓ Provide an **exciting, balanced curriculum** and meet the individual needs of your child
- ✓ **Set, monitor and provide feedback on homework** as appropriate
- ✓ **Monitor and discuss your child's achievement** through parents' interviews and annual written reports, informing you of your child's effort and what s/he needs to learn and do next
